Educational Research

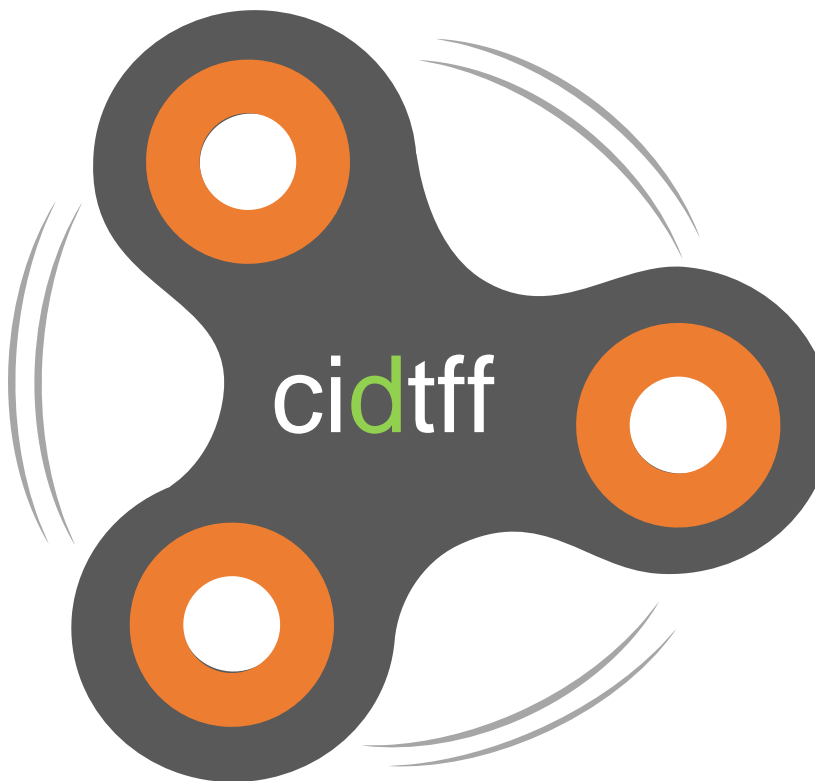
- Production of scientific knowledge committed to the search for solutions and answers to needs and problems felt at the local, national and transnational levels.

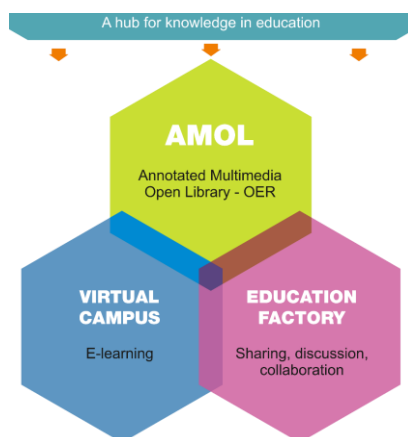
